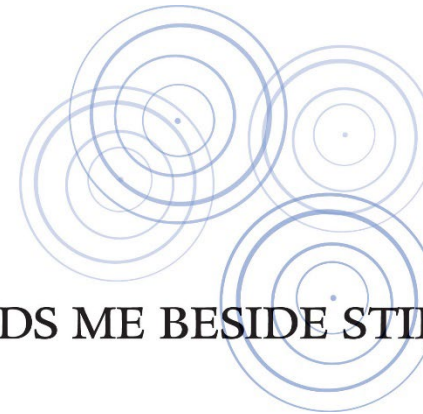
CALL TO PRAYER
